Site Rules

Please remember that off roading can still be dangerous, so please read and follow the rules in full to ensure you have a safe and enjoyable visit.

These rules apply to all persons using the site:

1. The site is open from 10am to 4pm. Please leave the site by closing times.
2. If you have never gone off road before you must notify the gate staff, we do however encourage people to have some tuition before driving off road for the first time, this can be arranged by pre-booking.
3. We have a blanket speed limit of 5mph, which must be followed. Anyone found to be speeding around the site will be removed; please respect the site and others using the site.
4. All persons must wear correct fitting seatbelts, no standing in vehicles.
5. Vehicles may be safety checked upon entry, The marshals and management have the right to scrutinise any vehicles, at any time and to exclude any vehicle, which is considered not to be safe for off road use.
6. Drivers must not be under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
7. All drivers must have a full UK driving license for the type of vehicle they are using.
8. Marshals will be on hand to give any help, advice – guidance or recovery on various aspects of driving or winching on the site, but any liability for any injury to person or damage to vehicles arising out of such advice or guidance is expressly excluded.
9. Please don't obstruct parts of the site by parking up to watch others please park so that others may pass safely.
10. If you are not sure whether to drive a route get out and have a look first. The Golden Rule if in doubt DON'T DO IT! Please check all routes before driving.
11. Please respect that any decision made by the management or a marshal is final and is to be respected.
12. No refund will be offered if a customer's visit has been cut short for whatever reason.
13. If you are found to be ignoring the rules set out you will be removed from site.
14. No alcohol or illegal substances allowed on site.
15. An adult must supervise children at all times.
16. Pets (are not encouraged on site) must be kept on a short lead if they are out of a vehicle.
17. Noise to be kept to a minimum.
18. Areas roped, marked Out of Bounds or No Entry must not to be entered or used. Any person found doing so will be removed from the site immediately.
19. The use of horns and sirens are forbidden on the site unless there is an emergency.
20. Trees on the site must not be damaged.
21. All vehicles are to be cleared of excess mud before leaving the site.
22. In the case of an accident or injury contact a club official or marshal immediately.
23. Anyone found making new tracks (without Bures Pit Enterprises LLP approval) will be asked to leave the site.
24. Please stay with your vehicle if you are stuck or have broken down.
25. All non-participating vehicles must remain in the designated car park.
26. Refuelling of vehicles must only take place in the designated area marked "refuelling only"
27. All litter/rubbish must be taken home with you.

Vehicle Specification

1. All vehicles must be mechanically sound to be allowed on site.
2. All vehicles must be fitted with an adequate silencer/exhaust system to pass a noise test if required. Not exceeding 98 dbs at ¾ max revs when measured at 0.5 metres from the exhaust.
3. All vehicles must have: - Fire extinguisher (securely attached), suitable towrope, tow points front and rear, First Aid Kit Anything inside the vehicle must be securely fastened down.
4. No quads, trikes or motorbikes will be allowed to take part in pay and play days.
