## Participants Briefing

By placing yourselves in the starting position you are Self-Certificating and declaring acceptance of the Course and its preparation, condition and suitability for the activity you intent to share with others.

You are accepting that the activity involves the use of the home built or modified vehicles.

You are accepting that you are in joint enterprise with others, in a shared activity, who may lose control of their vehicles and make contact with you or your vehicle.

You undertake not to seek compensation for such injury or damage.

You also undertake to monitor all conditions and withdraw from the activity should you believe that any changing adversely affect the level of risk you are prepared to accept.

The speed limit on site is 5 MPH everywhere.

Refuelling will not be allowed in any public area, but can take place in marked area of the pits.

Fire Extinguishers are positioned at Marshal point shown on the site map.

If any vehicle requires 'jacking' to facilitate repairs 2 means of support must be used.

The signal to start is a green flag.

The signal to stop is a red flag.

Significant hazards on the course are:

- Steep inclines/declines
- Slippery surfaces
- Deep mud
- Water
- Stationary vehicles
- Overhanging trees/brambles

If you are withdrawn from the activity prematurely you must inform the signing on office as you leave.

The Event Control Point is situated at the signing on office at the entrance. Exit from the course is via the signing on office.
